

'History and Our Responsibility' TP Sun Myung Moon 1978 July 16th London UK

In his July 16, 1978, speech in London, TP Sun Myung Moon outlines "History and Our Responsibility," . He emphasizes the urgent responsibility of followers to unite with God's providence to establish true families and overcome historical, spiritual, and physical obstacles.

Key themes from this 1978 address include:

- Context of History:** History is viewed as a struggle between good and evil, necessitated by the Fall of Man.

- Divine Responsibility:** God has been working through history to find individuals who can fulfill the responsibility that was failed at the beginning; since the first human ancestors became false parents, under the dominion of Satan who became the false god of this world . And this gave rise to the dysfunctional world that we became accustomed to.

- Role of the Followers:** The responsibility of believers is to take action, align with the True Parents, and fulfill the mission to create a true family.

- Now is the Time:** The message states that this is now the time to reverse the effects of the fall.

This message was delivered as part of the 'One World Crusade' in 1978.
